## **Objective**

At Sprowston Infant School we believe that children will learn best if parents know, understand and are in agreement with the aims and values of the school. This agreement is to help the school and parents to work in partnership in order to support the children's learning.

#### The parents/carers will:

- 1. Las a Parent/Carer will:
- 2. Make sure that my child will arrive at school by 8.45 am.
- 3. Make sure that my child is wearing named school uniform or other suitable clothing and that their PE kit is brought into school at the beginning of each week.
- 4. Endeavour to provide a safe, secure and happy environment at home for my child, acknowledging that they learn at home.
- 5. Let the school know of any concerns or worries that may be affecting my child's learning or behaviour.
- 6. Attend Parents evenings and meetings with my child's teacher and other staff, aiming to be positive and productive, working towards moving my child on in their learning.
- 7. Support the schools policies and guidelines especially for behaviour.
- 8. Read all information sent home as this gives me important details of relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities, newsletters and open days.
- 9. Support your child in homework or any other opportunities for home learning.
- 10. Inform the school of any absences as soon as possible on the first day.

## The school will:

- 1. Provide your child with a good standard of education, within a balanced curriculum.
- 2. Ensure that our learning environment is stimulating and challenging.
- 3. Celebrate your child's academic and personal achievements.
- 4. Care for your child's safety and well-being by observation and listening to them.
- 5. Teach your child to develop a positive attitude to one another, regardless of gender, race, culture, belief, values, age and need.
- 6. Regularly meet with you to communicate the progress of your child, celebrating their strengths and explaining how we can support them in their areas for development.
- 7. Provide information to you about our school, including relevant policies, meetings, workshops, activities, newsletters and open days.
- 8. Set differentiated and achievable homework to extend the curriculum and provide the opportunity for independent learning. Clear information will be provided so that you will be able to help your child if required.

- 9. Encourage and support your child to do their best at school
- 10. Establish clear and relevant policies, guidelines, visions and values for the whole school community to follow.
