	Teaching Learning and Curriculum (TLC)					
	This committee monitors the educational performance of the school and its pupils.					
	A Panel of Governors are responsible for the Performance review of the Head Teacher with support from a suitably qualified person from the Local Authority.

The main advantage of using this service is that the Clerk will: "provide guidance and advice on procedural, constitutional and legal matters and ensure meetings are conducted within the appropriate legal framework"
	• Supported the monitoring of the school website. The Governing body review the website to ensure it meets usability and legal requirements.
	• The Governing Body has reviewed all required Policies to support the school in following best practice and meeting its legal obligations over the past twelve months. Where appropriate these are based on template policies provided by the authority.
	• The school has a Governor responsible for Safeguarding (Child Protection) who reports on safeguarding matters to the Governing body termly.
	• The Governing Body supports the School Improvement and Development Plan (SIDP), ensuring that the School Budget supports the SIDP and that they are affordable. Progress against the plan is monitored at each meeting.
	 Extra meetings have been held this year as needed to support the Headteacher in the challenging circumstances.
	Buildings Finance and Grounds (BFG)
	• The BFG Committee 'walk around the school' each term to ensure the buildings and grounds are safe, secure and sound. This has not been possible this year due to Coronavirus. The Headteacher has regularly updated governors regarding any Premises issues.
	• The BFG Committee have worked with the school leadership team and Norfolk Finance Services for schools to ensure the school budget is set to support the School Improvements that are supporting Sprowston Infant School in its aim to be an outstanding school for all our learners. The Finance Governor has attended meetings virtually.

	 Pupil attendance is monitored on a termly basis and reasons for persistent absence are understood. The Governors support the school leadership in the steps it is taking to encourage attendance at school, particularly in this most challenging year. Teaching Learning and Curriculum (TLC) The TLC Committee has discussed the key data relating to pupil achievement and progress. They have supported the initiatives put in place by the school leadership team to ensure progress in areas of weakness whilst maintaining good progress in all areas. Maths and English subject leaders present improvement plans regularly A Governor has specific responsibility to understand and monitor the impact of the interventions funded by the Pupil Premium and Sports Premium grants. <i>All monitoring has taken place remotely during this school year</i>. Minutes of Governing Body and Committee meetings are public documents, which are available from the school office.
